



SRM High School Youth Forum – Call for Delegates February 16-20, 2020, Denver, CO

Do you know a high school student who is excited about Rangelands? Would they be interested in learning more about range with other high school students from across North America? In 1966 the SRM recognized a need to involve youth with the range-related activities and education provided at this annual meeting. Since that time, the High School Youth Forum (HSYF) has been a highlight of the SRM annual meetings.

Each SRM Section may take up to three HSYF delegates to the International SRM meeting. The Idaho Section is seeking high school students who are interested in learning more about rangelands, interacting with range professionals and other high school students from throughout North America, writing a paper, and preparing and giving a 6-8 minute presentation on a range topic.
